At this time, the Library's public computer workstations, accessed by 32,244 patrons during FY05/06, have been in continual use for 5 to 7 years, are rapidly approaching the end of productivity and do not meet new technology standards. By doing this we are able to trade cars at about 70,000 miles and receive a substantial trade-in allowance. Under the new system mileage should be lower and trade-in value higher. Experience has shown the bulk of the major mechanical problems such as trasmission or engine failure occur as the cars approach the 75,000-80,000 mile range. It is not cost effective to spend \$1,400.00 for a transmission rebuild or \$3,000.00 for a motor rebuild on a vehicle that averages \$3,000.00 on a trade-in. The optimum time to trade the cars is at 3 year/70,000 miles.
