Residents Can Now Submit Traffic Authority Requests Online

STRATFORD— Stratford residents may now submit requests for stop signs, speed restrictions, and other traffic control measures to the Stratford Traffic Authority via the town's website.

“The Town of Stratford’s Traffic Authority is required by the Town Charter to approve all signage and restrictions pertaining to traffic and street parking,” said Mayor Harkins. “In order to make it easier for residents to make a request to this body, I am pleased to announce that residents may submit their proposals online. After submitting their request, residents will receive follow up information from town staff including the date of the Traffic Authority meeting at which the submission will be considered. Residents are encouraged to attend the Traffic Authority Meeting at which their proposal will be considered in order to advocate for their request.”
