



Sick Policy

Section 19-13B42(r) of the Connecticut Public Health Code

No person while affected with any disease in a communicable form, or while a carrier of such disease, or while afflicted with boils, infected wounds, sores or an acute respiratory infection, shall work in any area of a food service establishment in any capacity in which there is a likelihood of such person contaminating food, drink or food contact surfaces with pathogenic organisms, or transmitting disease to other individuals; and no person known or suspected of being affected with any such disease or condition shall be employed in such an area or capacity.

If the management of the food service establishment has reason to suspect that any employee has contracted any disease in a communicable form or has become a carrier of such disease, he shall notify the local director of health immediately.

Employees must be excluded from work if he or she is diagnosed with an illness due to:

Bacillus Cereus	Botulism	Campylobacter
Clostridium Perfringens	E. Coli	Hepatitis A
Listeria	Norwalk-like virus	Salmonella Typhus
Scombroid Toxin	Shigella ssp	StaphAureus
Trichinosis	Vibrio infection	

Employee must not be allowed to back to work without a physician's authorization.

Employees must be restricted from food handling and ware washing if they have the following symptoms:

Diarrhea	Sore throat with fever	Fever with GI symptoms
Vomiting	Jaundice	Lesions containing pus

Infections, cuts and open sores must be properly covered with an impermeable cover or the worker must be excluded from food related work. This includes all food service and ware washing personnel.
