



**Rabies Clinic, Microchip Clinic & Dog Licensing Event

Rabies Clinic

The Town of Stratford and the Connecticut Veterinary Medical Association will be conducting a rabies clinic at the **Stratford Town Hall**, located at 2725 Main Street on Sunday, **May 2nd from 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.** **Dogs must be on leashes and cats must be in carriers.** There are no residency requirements.

The rabies vaccination fee is \$20 per animal (cash only). Persons who present their state assistance ID cards will be given one free vaccination.

One-year vaccinations will be given, unless a valid rabies certificate or dog license showing a prior vaccination is presented to qualify for a three-year vaccination. Tags are not sufficient proof for a three-year vaccination. According to Connecticut State Law, all dogs & cats, three months of age or older must be vaccinated against rabies. Vaccinating your pets for rabies helps to reduce the threat rabies poses to public health, while protecting your pet from the virus.

Micro Chip Clinic

Stratford Animal Control will hold a microchip clinic at the same time as the rabies clinic. The cost is \$20 per animal (cash only). Please call Animal Control at 203-385-4068 for more information.

Dog Licensing

Dog Licensing will be available at the Rabies Clinic. All dogs must obtain a dog license between June 1st & June 30th every year, pursuant to Sec. 22-338 CGS. When a spayed or neutered dog is licensed for the first time, or has been spayed or neutered after being licensed last year, a certificate from a licensed veterinarian must be presented. Dog Licensing is for Stratford residents only.

Cost for Dog Licenses

\$8.00 for spayed and neutered dogs.

\$19.00 non-spayed/neutered
