Title of Project: Stratford Police Department Crime Analysis Facilities Improvements

Amount of Grant: \$23,056

Program Description: The Town of Stratford Police Department will utilize its 2010 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant to build upon efforts to improve the Department's ability to conduct proactive policing. Previous JAG grants have been used to upgrade administrative and patrol technology, including PC and MDT replacement, and implementation of GIS-based crime mapping. The 2010 grant will be used to make physical improvements to the department's facilities that will be used in crime analysis and will enable the Police Department to be more responsive to the Town's policing and public safety needs. The grant will be used to purchase new furniture for its Crime Analysis Room and the Training Room. Currently, both rooms are furnished with antiquated, worn-out and inadequate chairs and tables that should be replaced with furnishings that are suitable for the rooms' new use. These two rooms will be used on a regular basis to analyze crime data and discuss trends with officers and administrative leadership that will inform our policing strategy and assist in resource and personnel deployment.
