In accordance with the Town of Stratford's Citizen Participation Plan (CPP), notice is hereby given of the following proposed substantial amendment, as approved unanimously at a duly posted meeting of the Community Development Subcommittee on Tuesday, March 22, 2016, to the following Town of Stratford Consolidated Housing and Community Development Strategy Plan Annual Action Plan:

**Proposed Change to 2015 Action Plan**

**Reduce Funding:** CD Project #4115– Planning and Administration. Funding for project reduced from \$90,000 to \$75,000. Funding of \$15,000 reallocated in full to CD Project #4109.

**Increase Funding:** CD Project #4109 – Stratford Housing Authority Vacant Unit Repair. Funding for project increased from \$10,000 to \$25,000.
