

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING

STRATFORD, CONNECTICUT - the Town of Stratford has a project for the Town of Stratford's proposed improvements to West Broad St from Linden Ave to California St / Knowlton St. Preliminary design has been completed and the project is slated for construction funding under the Surface Transportation Program administered by the Connecticut Department of Transportation.

It is the Town's and the State's policy to keep persons informed and involved when such projects are undertaken. It is important that the community share its concerns to assist in the project's development. The Town of Stratford will conduct an informational meeting on June 9, 2015 at 6:00 pm in the Town Council Chambers of the Town Hall, 2725 Main St, Stratford, CT

It is planned that the project will include but not be limited to drainage improvements, intersection upgrades, including a new traffic Signal and right hand turn at the I-95 off-ramp on Linden Ave, driveway realignments, new pavement and curbing, and pedestrian signals.

Based upon a preliminary assessment, the construction cost will be approximately \$5,392,850.

The Federal Highway Administration will provide 80% of the construction cost with the State and the Town providing 10% each.
