- c. Route 110, Main Street Putney – Request a traffic light at this intersection

MR. MCCARTHY MADE A MOTION TO REMOVE THIS ITEM FROM THE AGENDA AND REFER IT TO THE STATE DOT FOR CONSIDERATION, SECONDED BY LT. EANNOTTI. MR. MCCARTHY STATED THIS IS A STATE ROAD AND THEY HAVE COMPLETE CONTROL. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY A VOTE OF 4-0.

- d. Whippoorwill Lane and Florence Street – Request to add street signs with the names of “Whippoorwill Lane” and “Florence Street”

MR. MCCARTHY MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THIS ITEM, SECONDED BY LT. EANNOTTI. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY A VOTE OF 4-0.

- e. 45 Frances Place – Residents request for limited parking signs during the weekdays on the cul-de-sac

MR. MCCARTHY MADE A MOTION TO TABLE THIS ITEM AND REFER IT TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY A VOTE OF 4-0.
