MR. MCCARTHY MADE A MOTION TO ADD A NEW ITEM TO THE AGENDA RESTRICTING PARKING ON SHORT BEACH RD., RIVERDALE DR., AND SIDE STREETS INTO RIVERDALE. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY OFFICER IANNUCCI. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

RESIDENTS HAVE COMPLAINED TO DEPUTY CHIEF MCNEIL THAT BEACHGOERS PARK AT THIS LOCATION TO AVOID FEES. MR. NOCERA MADE A MOTION TO RESTRICT PARKING CONTINGENT UPON A LETTER TO RESIDENTS AFFECTED, WITH A RESOLUTION FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO POSTING SIGNAGE. MR. MCCARTHY MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THIS ITEM, SECONDED BY OFFICER IANNUCCI. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY A VOTE OF 4-0.
