1. CALL TO ORDER – Chairman Chris Tymniak made a motion to call the meeting to order at 2:30 PM. Motion was approved by Mr. McCarthy and seconded by Lt. Eannott. Motion passed unanimously.
2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Mr. Tymniak made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held March 17, 2016 and the special meeting of March 29, 2016. Motion was approved by Mr. McCarthy and seconded by Lt. Eannotti. Motion passed unanimously.

- b. 128 Klondike Street – Request for a “No Parking” sign at this location

Chris Tymniak made a motion for discussion. Mr. McCarthy made a motion to refer this item to the Police Department for investigation seconded by Lt. Eannotti. Motion passed unanimously. Lt. Eannotti made a motion to table this item seconded by Mr. McCarthy. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 4-0.

c. Honeyspot Rd - Request for “No Parking” signs in front of UPS

Lt. Eannotti recommended five signs for the ease of the trucks and customers at the UPS Honeyspot Rd location. Mr. McCarthy made a motion to approve seconded by Lt. Eannotti. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

d. Riverdale Drive, Short Beach Rd – Request for installation of restricted parking May 1st through September 30th

Lt. Eannotti stated this item was to correct a previous vote from last year. Mr. McCarthy recommended limited parking for people accessing Short Beach to prevent blocking of traffic and driveways. Lt. Eannotti recommended installation of 15 restricted parking signs. Mr. McCarthy made a motion to approve seconded by Lt. Eannotti. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 4-0.

Mr. Tymniak made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Mr. McCarthy. Motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 2:38PM.
