1. CALL TO ORDER – Chairman Chris Tymniak made a motion to call the meeting to order at 2:32 PM. Motion was approved by Mr. McCarthy and seconded by Tom Albert. Motion passed unanimously.
  
2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Mr. Tymniak made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on August 18, 2016. Motion was approved by Mr. McCarthy and seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 3-0.
  
3. NEW BUSINESS
  - a. Lincoln St - Request for a speed bump on Lincoln Street across from Wooster Middle School  
Mr. McCarthy made a motion to deny this request seconded by Mr. Albert. Mr. McCarthy stated speed bumps are not placed on public conveyances. Motion carried by a vote of 3-0.
  
  - b. Elm Street and Blakeman Place – Request two or three, 2-hour parking signs  
Mr. McCarthy made a motion to approve a 2-hour parking sign at this location seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 3-0.

- c. Maple Oak Reserve request for the following:
- I) Intersection warning signs posted at the proper distance before Maple Oak Drive  
Mr. McCarthy made a motion to deny this request seconded by Mr. Albert. Mr. McCarthy stated this is not required under federal standard. Motion carried unanimously by a vote of 3-0.
  - II) General brush and trees removed from Maple Oak Dr. to Brinsmayd Ave.  
Mr. McCarthy made a motion to remove this item from the agenda because it is not a Traffic Authority issue seconded by Mr. Albert. Mr. McCarthy made a motion to deny and remove seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion carried unanimously by a vote of 3-0.
  - III) Traffic Law violation enforcement  
Mr. McCarthy made a motion to refer this item to the Traffic Division for investigation seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 3-0.
  - IV) Replacement of disintegrating roadway on the westbound section of Warner Hill between Pilgrim Lane and prior to the entrance way to the Tudor Ridge Condos  
Mr. McCarthy made a motion to remove this item from the agenda. Mr. McCarthy made a motion to refer this item to the Highway Maintenance Division seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 3-0.
- d. Bike Greenway Project discussion  
Mr. McCarthy made a motion to approve the Greenway project seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 3-0.
- e. 33 King Street - Request for a no parking sign on the corner of Broadbridge Ave  
Mr. McCarthy made a motion to add 33 King Street to the agenda seconded by Mr. Albert. Mr. Tymniak made a motion for discussion. Cars park in very small curb area which blocks the view. Mr. McCarthy made a motion to approve this item seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 3-0.
