The Stratford Traffic Authority conducted a regular meeting on Thursday, October 20, 2016 pursuant to notice duly posted.

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Chris Tymniak, Maurice McCarthy, Tom Albert, and Officer Robert Joy

**OTHERS PRESENT:** Greg Cann and John Davidson

1. **CALL TO ORDER** – Chairman Chris Tymniak made a motion to call the meeting to order at 2:32PM. Motion was approved by Mr. McCarthy and seconded by Tom Albert. Motion passed unanimously.
  
2. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – Mr. Tymniak made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on September 15, 2016. Motion was approved by Mr. McCarthy and seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 4-0.
  
3. **TABLED ITEMS**
  - a. Discussion of State proposal to reconstruct East Broadway intersection with Ferry Blvd  
  
Mr. Chris Tymniak made a motion to keep this item on the table. Motion was approved by Mr. McCarthy and seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed unanimously.
  
4. **NEW BUSINESS**
  - a. Benjamin & Light St – Request to keep four-way stop signs at this location.  
  
Mr. McCarthy made a motion to approve this item seconded by Officer Robert Joy. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 4-0.

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- b. Canaan Rd. & Franklin Ave – Request to add a four-way stop sign at this location.

Mr. McCarthy made a motion to refer this item to the Police Department for investigation, seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 4-0.

- c. Oak Bluff Ave - Request for speed limit signs, a stop sign going toward the beach, and a radar speed limit sign.

Mr. McCarthy made a motion to add a 25 MPH speed limit sign and monitor the area for one to two weeks with a radar trailer. Mr. McCarthy also made a motion to refer this item to the Police Department for enforcement seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 4-0.

- d. Hamilton Ave – Request for a 25 MPH speed limit sign and a “Slow Children Crossing” sign.

Mr. McCarthy made a motion to approve a 25 MPH speed limit sign, seconded by Mr. Albert. Mr. Tymniak made a motion to monitor the area. There is no enforcement for “Slow Children Crossing” signs. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 4-0.

- e. Sunnybank Ave & Sunnydale Place - Request to install a mirror to see oncoming traffic on the Wooster Park side of Sunnybank Ave.

Mr. McCarthy made a motion to refer this item to the Police Department for investigation, seconded by Mr. Albert. Motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

- f. 1166 Barnum Ave & 443-445 King Street- Request a review for zoning application.

Mr. McCarthy made a motion to refer this item to the Traffic Division before making a decision, seconded by Mr. Albert. Mr. Tymniak stated, discussion will take place during the December 2016 meeting. Motion passed unanimously by a vote of 4-0.

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g. Approve the 2017 Traffic Authority Schedule

Mr. Tymniak made a motion for discussion of the 2017 Traffic Authority schedule. Mr. McCarthy approved the 2017 Traffic Authority, seconded by Mr. Albert. The motion passed unanimously by a vote of 4-0.

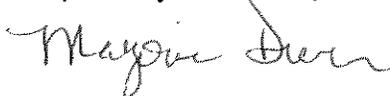
h. Klondike St at McQuillan St. – Request to replace stop sign at the end
