PERMITS AND REVIEWS — Certificate of Permission application received from CT DEEP re: expand an existing “living shoreline” in the intertidal zone adjacent to the northern shore of the former Lordship Gun club. The living shoreline will include an artificial reef and subsequent establishment of a smooth cordgrass (*Spartina alterniflora*) marsh. In total, the project will provide an additional 750 feet of coastal erosion control and approximately 4.5 acres of intertidal wetland habitat. The artificial reef will be constructed using pre-cast cement “reef balls” and will serve as a strategically placed barrier to dissipate wave energy and associated scour. Alteration of these processes will create favorable conditions for the establishment of smooth cordgrass, which is intended to restore the marsh that was historically present at the site.
