**Call To Order**

Greta Broneill called the meeting to order at 11:06 a.m.

**Data Dissemination Plan/ Timeline**

The first step is to present the 2016 Search Institute Survey and Supplemental Survey results to the Stratford Partnership at their next meeting on September 13, 2016. Nina Chanana will prepare the presentation and facilitate discussion.

The Data STAT, with additional Coalition members, brainstormed ways to release the data to the various sectors of the Stratford community. The following summarizes the discussion:

- Youth – Youth Committee is developing a social norms number campaign for their peers and the community.
- Schools—Important data points should be sent to all SPS employees in e-mail form—“Making a difference”; include 2-3 bullet data points; Partnership for Youth and Families exists and these are their goals; Increasing Assets—Talk Early, Talk Often
- Law Enforcement—Poster for the lobby; and roll call room—“keeping the community and kids safe”
- Elected Officials—Important data points should be sent in e-mail form; also mentioned doing a quarterly newsletter to all elected officials—Town/School/State and Federal; In addition present the data at a Town Council meeting
- Parents/Families—Have information available at Open Houses
- Business—anyone providing services to youth should receive the data; Assets= kids you can hire; Stratford is a positive place for families;
  - Real Estate (Commercial Brokers) have a luncheon once a month; for Residential Brokers add the importance of safe guarding medications especially for open houses/showings during sale of a home

Also, members discussed uploading a PowerPoint with more information and highlighting parental and peer disapproval rates of use of substances, binge drinking, driving and driving rates, as well as highlight the top Assets and the 5 priority assets. A press release should be distributed, guiding readers toward the website where the PowerPoint and more information will be available. The STAT discussed having the data be disseminated during September and October.
