The Town of Stratford has been awarded a \$200,000 Brownfield Cleanup Grant from the United States Environmental Protection Agency for activities associated with the remediation and demolition of the former Mercer Coal Facility located at 2350 Stratford Avenue, Stratford, Connecticut.

As part of the grant award process, the Town of Stratford is required to obtain public input on the Town's Community Relations Plan (CRP) and on the draft Analysis of Brownfields Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA). Starting on September 25th, 2014, the Community Relations Plan (CRP) and draft Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup and Alternatives will be available for public review on the Town of Stratford's website (www.townofstratford.com) and at the Stratford Town Hall in the Town Clerk's Department (2725 Main Street, Stratford, Connecticut)

The Town of Stratford will also discuss the Community Relation Plan (CRP) and draft ABCA and consider response to comments at a public meeting on September 25th, 2014 at 4 pm in Room 213 of the Stratford Town Hall at 2725 Main Street, Stratford, Connecticut.
