Summary

Provide a safe environment, while preventing injury and loss of life at the municipal beaches. Performs the duties of the Head Lifeguard in their absence.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Be familiar with all job descriptions for lifeguard positions and ensure that they are carried out.

Assists in development of Lifeguard Manual

Assist in Development, plan and implementation of lifeguard training program

Supervise and coordinate all Lifeguard activities.

Inspect beach areas and practice emergency rescue skills/plans.

Enforce safety and administer first aid.

Assist in evaluating and disciplining staff.

Assist in ordering and maintaining equipment

Education and/or Experience

Associate's degree (A.A.) or equivalent from two-year college or technical school; or six months to one year related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

CPR, BLS, First Aid, Bloodborne Pathogen training, Lifeguard training plus 2-3 years of previous guarding (over 20 years of age), current valid Driver's License
