Summary

Plans, supervises, and implements a seven-week summer Playground Program, Sports Camp Program for children ages 5-15. Responsible for supervising the summer program staff.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following:

- Trains, supervise, disciplines, schedules and evaluates staff.
- Maintains and distributes equipment.
- Develops programs and new activities.
- Recommend new programs and equipment.
- Addresses complaints and resolves problems.
- Other duties may be assigned.

Supervisory Responsibilities

Oversees all camp activities and staff. Manages subordinate supervisors who supervise a total of 50-70 employees in the Recreation Department. Is responsible for the overall directions, coordination and evaluation of this unit. Carries out supervisory responsibilities in accordance with the organization's policies and applicable laws. Responsibilities include training employees; planning, assigning and directing work; appraising performance; rewarding and disciplining employees; addressing complaints and resolving problems.
