

Posting for Head Beach Lifeguard

Provide a safe environment, while preventing injury and loss of life at the municipal beaches.

Be familiar with all job descriptions for lifeguard positions and ensure that they are carried out.

Test lifeguards during the hiring process

Develop Lifeguard Manual

Develop, plan and implement lifeguard training program

Supervise and coordinate all Lifeguard activities.

Inspect beach areas and practice emergency rescue skills/plans.

Enforce safety and administer first aid.

Prepare schedule and submit payroll.

Evaluate and discipline staff.

Associate's degree (A.A.) or equivalent from two-year college or technical school; or six months to one year related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

CPR, BLS, First Aid, Bloodborne Pathogen training, Lifeguard training plus 2-3 years of previous guarding (over 20 years of age), current valid Driver's License
