



Head Lifeguard

The Town of Stratford is currently accepting applications for the position of Head Lifeguard for the town's Recreation Department. Position is responsible for providing a safe environment, while preventing injury and loss of life at the municipal beaches.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following (other duties may be assigned as needed):

- Supervise all Lifeguards on duty.
- Inspect beach areas and practice emergency rescue skills/plans.
- Evaluate and discipline staff.
- Order and maintain equipment
- Performs all duties of Lifeguard
- Enforce safety and administer first aid.
- In charge of scene in an emergency situation unless Waterfront Director is present.
- Fills in for Waterfront Director when needed.
- Supervisory responsibilities in accordance with the organization's policies and applicable laws

Education and Experience:

Associate's degree (A.A.) or equivalent from two-year College or technical school; or six months to one year related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Required Certificates, Licenses and Registrations:

CPR, BLS, First Aid, Lifeguard training plus 2-3 years of previous, current valid Driver's License.
