Summary

Monitors activities in swimming areas to prevent accidents and provide assistance to swimmers by performing the following duties.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Thorough knowledge of rescue methods.
- Rescues swimmers in danger of drowning and administers first aid.
- Patrols pool and Enforces rules and regulations pertaining to the pool.
- Maintains order in swimming areas.
- Ability to enforce rules while being firm, tactful and impartial.
- Must have the ability to anticipate dangerous situations.
- Inspects and maintains facilities for cleanliness.
- Checks and maintains pool/beach equipment.

Qualifications: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

- Must pass Town of Stratford Recreation department water safety test.

Less than high school education; or up to one month related experience or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
