

Posting for Pool Supervisor

The Town of Stratford is seeking an experienced Pool Supervisor to assume this responsible position in the Town of Stratford Recreation Department. Position is responsible for the safety of people in swimming pool.

Summary

Plans, organizes, supervises the operations of the Flood Pool. Responsible for the lifeguards during open swims and the swim instructors during lessons.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Enforces rules and regulations pertaining to the pool.

Conducts in-service training.

Assists in the testing of lifeguards and assists in hiring staff.

Trains and assigns lifeguards, desk attendants, security staff and WSIs.

Maintains and submits payroll

Registers and conducts swim instruction.

Evaluates and disciplines staff.

Orders and maintains equipment.

Applies resuscitation and administers first aid.

Supervisory Responsibilities

Directly supervises 8-10 employees. Carries out supervisory responsibilities in accordance with the organization's policies and applicable laws. Responsibilities include interviewing, and training employees; planning, assigning, and directing work; appraising performance; rewarding and disciplining employees; addressing complaints and resolving problems.
