TOWN ESTABLISHES “TWO-HOUR PARKING” SIGNAGE AT SEA WALL, INCREASES POLICE PATROLS AND PARKING ENFORCEMENT AT SHORT BEACH AND SEA WALL

STRATFORD – The Town of Stratford is expanding the streets in the sea wall area where “Resident Parking Only” signage will be posted, as well as increasing Stratford Police patrols in the area of the beaches and the sea wall.

As summer kicks into gear, there has been an increase in activity, and Mayor Laura R. Hoydick wants to assure residents in the area that steps are being taken to address the associated concerns.

Effective immediately there will be additional “Resident Only Parking” signs installed along the following streets: Washington Parkway, West Hillside, First Avenue, Jefferson Street and Park Boulevard. In addition, “Two-Hour Parking” signs are now installed along the sea wall limiting parking at that location.

The Stratford Police Department will post dedicated details at the sea wall from 4:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. every Thursday – Sunday to enforce the restrictions. The Stratford Parking Authority will be stationed at the sea wall and Short Beach during the day where Stratford resident only parking is allowed.
