## **Sredzinski Promoted to Dispatch Superintendent**

STRATFORD – **Mayor Laura R. Hoydick** is announcing that Public Safety Dispatch Supervisor J.P. Sredzinski is being promoted to the position of Dispatch Superintendent effective immediately. In this post he will direct the operations of the Town’s Public Safety Dispatch Center.

“J.P. Sredzinski has distinguished himself through his service as supervisor in our Dispatch Center over the past nine years,” said **Mayor Laura R. Hoydick**. “In that post he has seen our town through numerous storms, critical events, and of course, a global pandemic. I am pleased to announce his promotion to this new level of responsibility as Dispatch Superintendent, and have every confidence that he will perform as admirably in this new role as he has in his prior role in service to the people of Stratford.”

Sredzinski grew up in Stratford, and is a graduate of Bunnell High School. He has served as Public Safety Dispatch Supervisors since 2011, is an active member of the Emergency Operations Center acting as the primary liaison between Dispatch and Police, Fire, Emergency Medical Services and all town agencies. He previously served as Director of Operations for Southwest CMED from 2003-2011.

Prior to Sredzinski’s promotion, the Stratford Dispatch Center was capably overseen by Mike Loiz, who is stepping back from this position to focus on Public Safety Training through his position as EMS Director.
