STRATFORD NAMES NEW TAX COLLECTOR AND TAX ASSESSOR

STRATFORD- Stratford Mayor **Laura R. Hoydick** has announced that **Selina Moschello** will serve as the Town's new Tax Collector, and **Donna Otlowski** will serve as the new Tax Assessor. Both of them bring valuable experience and knowledge to their new positions, and have been promoted from within their departments in Town Hall, the Mayor said.

In 2013 she moved to the Town of Hamden as a real estate appraiser, and later became Acting Assessor from June of 2017 to May of 2018. She joined the Town Hall team in Stratford in June of 2018, and served as Assistant Assessor before her promotion to Assessor.
