Stratford— The Town of Stratford Department of Community/Economic Development announces that due to current backlog of applications for the program and the current funding available that they are no longer distributing new applications for the Residential Rehabilitation Program. In addition, they are not accepting completed applications from homeowners until additional funding becomes available. The Residential Rehabilitation Program offers no-interest, forgivable loans of up to \$25,000 for a five-year term to make repairs to the homes of income-eligible single-family, cooperative, and condominium owners. Applications are taken on a first-come, first-served basis. The hold on the distribution of new applications and the receipt of completed applications is effective immediately. Interested homeowners are advised to continue to watch the Stratford Star and the Town's website for if, and when, the Department will begin to once again distribute new applications.
