New Spring & Summer Recreation Hours

To make things easier and more convenient for Stratford residents, the Stratford Recreation Office will open two nights a week during spring and summer for Beach Stickers. Starting May 2nd the office will be open until 830pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The office will no longer be open on Saturdays.

- Current resident beach stickers are good until June 30, 2019 and will be accepted until July 15, 2019 at Short Beach and Long Beach. The new 2021 stickers will be mailed in your car tax bills the last week of June.
- If you have a new vehicle, or are a new resident, you need to bring your current drivers license and car registration to the Recreation office (468 Birdseye Street) in order to receive your sticker. (If your current address is not indicated, please bring a copy of a utility bill or mortgage with your name and current address.)
- Non-residents can pay \$150.00 for a season pass (cash/credit only)
- Fee for a daily beach pass is \$20. Cash or Credit paid to the attendant at the beach. Fees are under consideration by the Town Council and subject to change.
