**Public Meeting: Stratford Coastal Resilience  
March 3, 2016**

(Town of Stratford) The Town of Stratford is developing a Coastal Resilience Plan to improve and facilitate the social, economic and ecological resilience of the Town to coastal flooding, the impacts of sea level rise and coastal erosion. Public participation is essential to the planning process.

The third and last Public Meeting will be held on March 3, 2016 at 6:00 pm at Town Hall Council Chambers, 2725 Main Street, Stratford, CT. The public, business owners and community leaders are all encouraged to attend.

The meeting will give the public an opportunity to learn about the draft plan. Participants will be able to review proposed resiliency projects. Participants will also have the opportunity to discuss their interest and concerns for implementing potential resiliency options in Stratford. The Town will build upon the feedback provided by participants during the meeting.

The Town of Stratford hired consulting team GZA GeoEnvironmental, Inc. and sub-consultants Jamie Caplan Consulting LLC and the Cecil Group to develop the Coastal Resilience Plan. The consulting team will lead the workshop.
