Christ Episcopal Church Stratford CT Burying Ground, 2000 Main Street

William Samuel Johnson, a framer of the Constitution and first president of Columbia lies buried in Christ Church Cemetery. Costumes guides will interpret his life as well as others who are interred in the historic cemetery from noon until 3 p.m.

## community


Sterling House Community Center, 2283 Main Street
