UPDATE ON PRIMARY ABSENTEE BALLOTS

STRATFORD – The Office of the Town Clerk would like to inform voters on the status of their Absentee Ballots for the upcoming August 11, 2020 Primaries.

Absentee Ballots were to be mailed on July 21st to voters who had applications on file prior to July 20th. All subsequent applications received after July 21st are to be mailed out on a daily basis.

The ballots are being mailed out by a Mail House company who had been chosen to do the work by the Office of the Secretary of the State.

We have been informed by the Secretary of the State's office that the Absentee Ballots were not mailed out on July 21st, and were just mailed to voters on July 27th. There has been no explanation for the delay.

The Town Clerk would like to inform all Voters to please fill out your Absentee Ballots as soon as possible. You may mail your ballot, but to save time as the Primary date draws closer, you may place it in the Ballot Drop box outside of the Town Hall building on Main Street.

We want to insure that your vote counts.
